KICK -OFF MEETING IN KRISTIANSAND

On November 11-12, the kick-off meeting of the project took place in the beautiful southern Norwegian city of Kristiansand. The most important task that partners need to do in the near future is to create content for A1, B1 and B2 modules for the project platforms https://www.playnorway.sih.lt/ and https://www.playsweden.sih.lt/

The platforms will be available on both computers and smartphones. The learning process will start from users creating their accounts. Each module will be divided into ten lessons. Learners will be able to study sequentially - learn module by module, or choose only the one they need.

All three modules for each language will start with easier lesson content and progress to increasingly difficult tasks and more complex vocabulary, gradually introducing more difficult situations and questions.

After mastering the material of each module, learners will be able to download the certificates of completion of the Norwegian and Swedish language A2, B1 and B2 level course.
